What you should do to prepare for the canine team:

- Generally, it is acceptable to observe the canine work from a door way, however if the dog is distracted you may be asked to step out of sight.
- Please remove all food items from the rooms that the dog will be searching. If there is food on the floor it will be necessary to remove it before the canine team arrives.
- Prior to our arrival, please remove all electronics/fragile items from the bed area and place in plain view. All valuables should be removed prior to our inspection (cash, credit cards, etc.).
- It is not necessary to strip bedding or remove items from the closets for the dog to search, however, if the dog alerts on an area, it may be necessary for the technician to remove bedding or items from the closets.
- Remove all pests (except fish). If you cannot remove your pet from the premises, please have them securely locked in a bathroom before the canine team arrives.
- If you have done any treatments for bed bugs, other insects, mold, etc., please inform the canine handler prior to the inspection.

What our teams will do:

- ➤ The handler will visually check the area to be inspected prior to using the canine team.
- > The dog will be worked on leash led around the room(s) or areas to be inspected.
- > The handler will note and/or mark any areas to be further addressed.
- Additional resources may consist of a CO2 detection device and/or a trained technician who visually searches the area.

Our goal is to determine if bed bugs are present. We will do this as efficiently and effectively as possible.
